# New Data Policy ASCAC Charge

To submit a report describing current policies and practices for disseminating research results in the fields relevant to the Advanced Scientific Computing Research Program.

The report should:

- Describe current policies and practices for disseminating research results, including written findings and digital data, in the fields relevant to the Advanced Scientific Computing Research Program.
- Identify which dissemination models, if any, successfully maximize the potential benefit of research results in a way that is sustainable within the research community.
- Identify any opportunities where public access policies or practices could enhance the discovery potential of Office of Science research results.

**The report should be finalized by July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011.**

# Computational Science Graduate Fellowship Charge

To look at the effectiveness and impact of DOE's Computational Science Graduate Fellowship (CSGF) as compared to other educational activities and on the quality and breadth of the program over the past decade.

The sub-committee should

- take into account the unique qualifications and skills of computational scientists and their role in the public and private sectors
- address the participation of women and under-represented minorities
- Identify the projected need for trained computational scientists in the DOE laboratories and for continued U.S. leadership in computational science.
