

Responsibilities

- Stand in front of the room, on the opposite side of the scorekeeper facing the audience
- Ensure that the rules are followed and that the room is quiet
- Ensure that no one signals/communicates with the competitors.
- If communication does occur during a match, ask the person to leave the room (without causing undue duress – please) and report the person to the closest Information Desk

Warnings

- If a rule is broken, enforce the penalty right away – please do NOT give a warning

Collect all used scratch papers

- Collect at the beginning of the match, at the half, and at the conclusion

Ensure that the clock starts and stops at the appropriate times

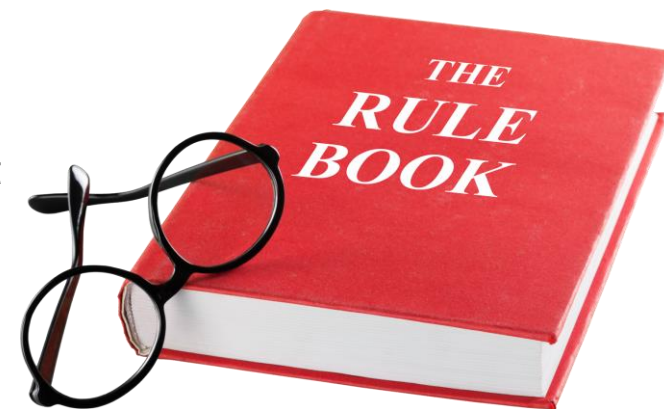
- The clock should be stopped during discussions between officials, and discussions between officials and students

Electronic Devices

- No one in the room is permitted to use any electronic devices

No one in the room may write anything during the matches

- Exception: coaches may mark the coach score sheets which will be either blue (middle school) or green (high school)
